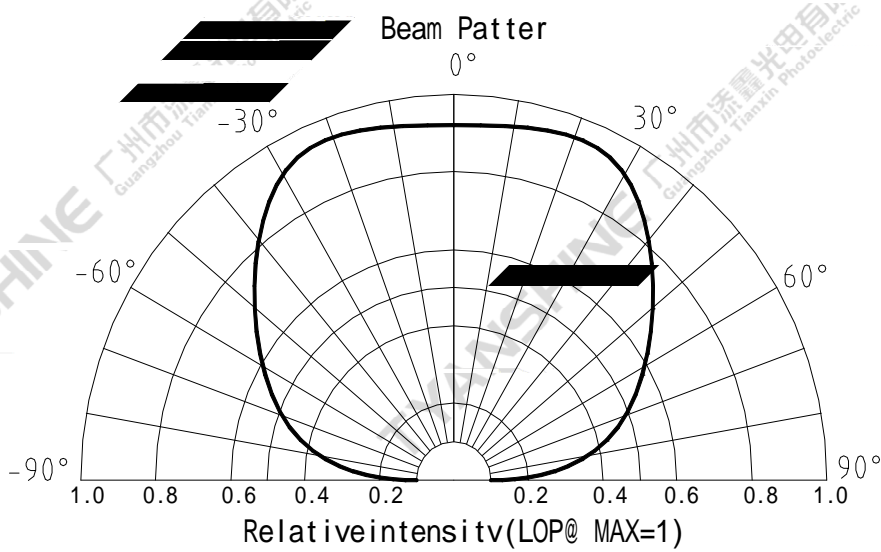
- Luminous intensity is measured with a light sensor and filter combination that approximates the CIE eye-response curve.

(25 " Ambient Temperature Unless Otherwise Noted)



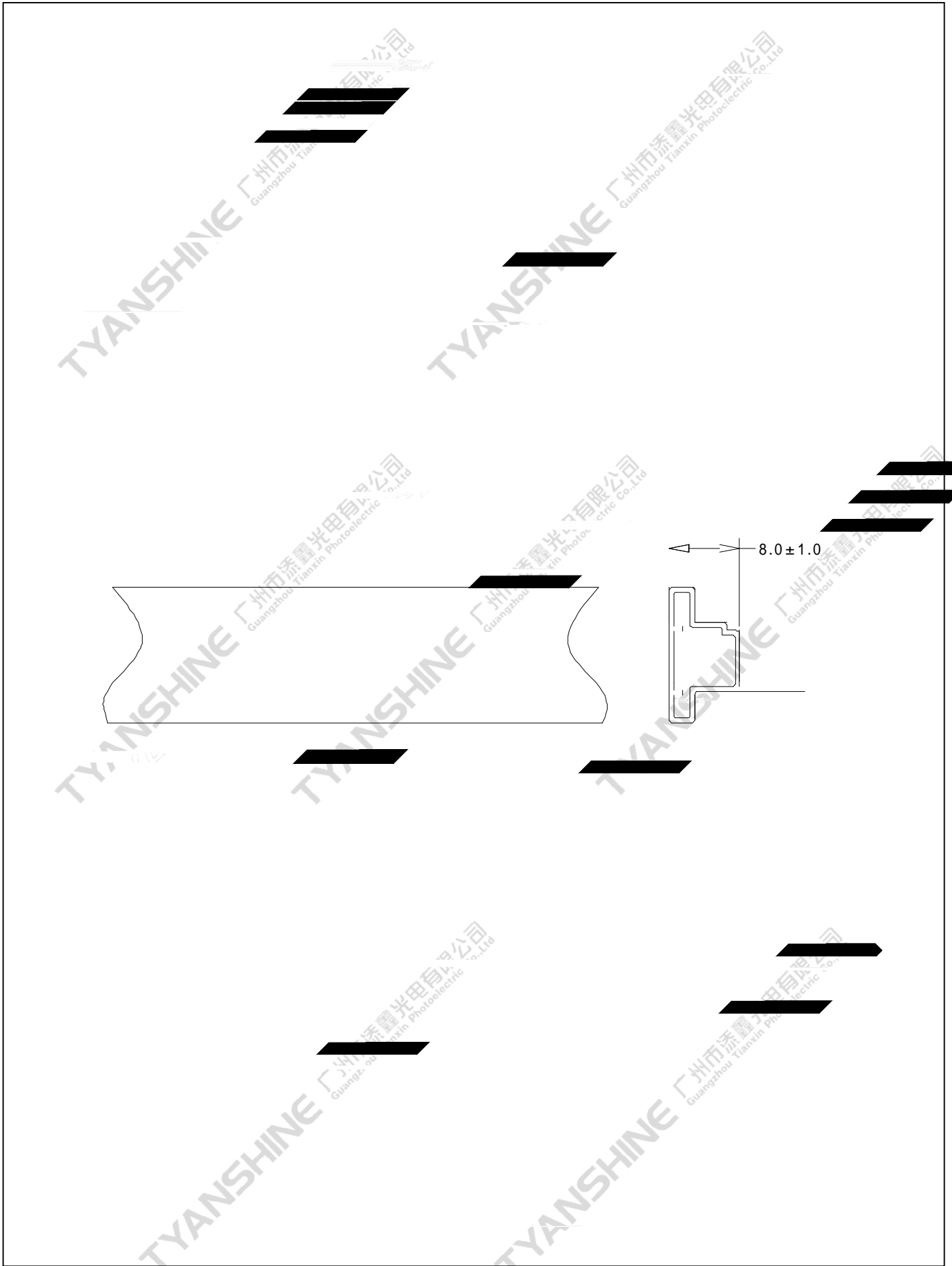




**Notes:**
